Adult Day Health Programs:

Our adult day health programs in Brookline, Roslindale and Roxbury offer elders access to health care, exercise, social and therapeutic activities, outings, and nutritious meals. These programs each offer a state-of-the-art Rogerson Fitness FIRSTSM program, and are designed to keep people active and engaged in their community.

MEMORY LOSS HOUSING & PROGRAMS

Rogerson House

Located on the Emerald Necklace in Jamaica Plain, this specially-designed facility offers assisted living for 66 people with memory loss and a day program for 24 participants, as well as respite care and family support groups. ※♦

Rogerson House Day Program

Uniquely designed for people in various stages of memory loss, this program offers a stimulating and structured environment. ※♦

Rogerson Roslindale Dementia Day Program

A program which offers adults with memory loss an array of therapeutic services and engaging activities, as well as access to health services. ※♦○

Allen House at Springhouse

This residential program, located within the Springhouse retirement community in Jamaica Plain, offers people with memory loss comfortable, secure assisted living. ■

Beacon House

85 subsidized and 50 moderately priced apartments on Beacon Hill for elders and people with disabilities. □※

Carleton House

44 affordable apartments for low-income individuals and families in the Egleston Square neighborhood of Boston. ※

Council Tower

144 subsidized apartments for elders and people with disabilities in Roxbury. ♦※○

Farnsworth House

75 subsidized apartments in Jamaica Plain for elders and people with disabilities. □♦※○

Florence House

17 moderately-priced cooperative apartments in Roslindale for people over age 55. ※♦○

Joy Street Residence

20 subsidized apartments on Beacon Hill for people living with HIV/AIDS. ※

Longfellow House

44 subsidized apartments for elders in Roslindale, surrounded by The Roslindale Public Gardens at Longfellow House. ※○

Peter Faneuil House

48 affordable apartments for families and individuals on Beacon Hill featuring the award-winning Peter Faneuil Garden. ※

Roslindale House

83 subsidized apartments in Roslindale for low-income elders and people with disabilities. ♦※○

Spencer House

46 subsidized apartments for low-income elders in Egleston Square. ♦※※○

Walnut House

A residential program operated by Bay Cove Human Services for 34 adults with disabilities in Egleston Square. ■

RETIREMENT COMMUNITIES

Community at Pond Meadow

66 single-story, clustered homes in Wrentham for independent seniors, with services available from the adjacent Pond Home. ※■

Hale Barnard Services

A 58-bed retirement community offering meals and 24-hour care in the Back Bay. ■

Pond Home

Rogerson directed the recent \$4 million renovation and expansion of the now 43-bed retirement and nursing home in Wrentham. ■

The Residences at Snow Place

66 newly constructed independent living units in West Roxbury, with services available from the adjacent Sophia Snow House. ※■

Sophia Snow House

36 new residential care suites offering privacy and the comforts of home in West Roxbury. ※■

Springhouse

52 independent living apartments, 61 assisted living suites, as well as 22 suites for individuals with memory loss in Jamaica Plain. ■
